





Overview of KRR

- This is our second year of running the KRR Program
- This year, 58 children in grades K-3 received tutoring through KRR 4 afternoons a week for 108 days during the school year
 - Kids are individually assessed on a continuous basis to find their reading levels & are then placed in small groups with other children on their level
- Certified tutors work with the children on their specific reading level in small groups of 8 or less
 - Instruction focuses on being hands-on and fun for the children. Games and sensory activities are planned with the goal that the children learn & practice reading skills in personalized, dynamic ways.
- Data is collected in the Fall, Winter & Spring to measure the children's improvements.





Eduardo Luna




- Began 2nd grade on a Kindergarten reading level.
- Improved by 83 points through the KRR program & ended the year on-grade level for 2nd grade.

Jackielynn Rivera



- Background: Father was deported and family was suffering. Jackie also wears a hearing aid.
- She had a 30 grade average last year at school. Her mother said she didn't know how to help her and asked if we would accept in the KRR program even though she was older.
- There were lots of tears at the beginning, but now Jackie is a happy adolescent who frequently brings home 100s and this is the first year she doesn't have to attend summer school.

Enrique Mendez



- When Enrique started the KRR Program in Fall 2016, he was in 2nd grade and could not read a single word on the benchmark test. His initial score was 0.
- After 2 years of hard work, he finished the KRR Program in Spring 2017 on his grade level for 3rd grade.
